2. USE IDENTIFIED PREFIX BELOW WHEN REQUESTING A PLAN FOR EXAMPLE: MISC22.
3. IF YOU ARE HAVING DIFFICULTY LOCATING YOUR PLAN USING THE PLANS PREFIX LIST; REVIEW THE INSTRUMENT PREFIX LIST AS THE PLAN MAY HAVE BEEN FILED AS AN INSTRUMENT. HIGHWAY PLANS, EXPROPRIATION PLANS MAY HAVE BEEN FILED AS AN INSTRUMENT. FOR EXAMPLE: LT47498.
4. \*PLAN NUMBER RANGES WITH BROKEN SERIES **DO NOT** RUN CONSECUTIVELY.
5. FOR DETAILED INFORMATION ON PLANS FILED IN THIS OFFICE REVIEW THE INDICES ON ONLAND.
6. FOR TOWNSHIP PLANS FILED IN THIS OFFICE REVIEW THE MOUNTED BOARD PLANS LISTING.
7. FOR MOUNTED BOARD PLAN LISTING GO TO SERVICEONTARIO PREFIXES AND CROSS-REFERENCES PAGE AND SELECT THE LINK TO REVIEW THE DETAILED LISTING.
